SLT ANZ is seeking a proactive and motivated self-starter with strong attention to detail and excellent organisation skills to help expand our primary fundraising program 'Adopt an Animal' across SEA LIFE Australia/New Zealand.

The position will require a 4 - 6 hour commitment per week, ideally over 1 day per week for at least 6 months.

Primary duties will include the following key responsibilities:

- Process & receipt donations;
- Maintain donor records, including data entry;
- Create marketing and promotional content for adoption program collateral including quarterly newsletters, press releases and brochures;
- Liaise with SEA LIFE marketing teams in Australia/New Zealand to expand the adoption program into all SEA LIFE sites;
- Assist with coordination and administration of at least 2 fundraising appeals per annum (1 per half year);
- Other administration duties as required.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants must have a legal right to volunteer in Australia. *Essential*

- Excellent computer skills, particularly data entry;
- Excellent communication skills;
- Excellent attention to detail;
- Good follow up and organisational skills;
- Experience coordinating a variety of tasks to a deadline;
- Ability to work as part of a team to achieve collective goals for the organisation.
